

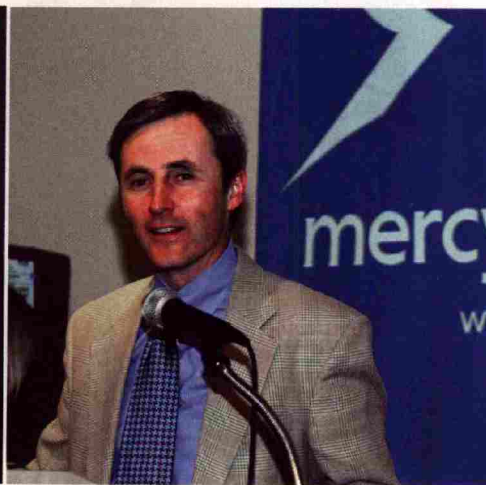
MERCYFIRST RAISES GREEN ON THE GREENS AT SPRING GOLF OUTING

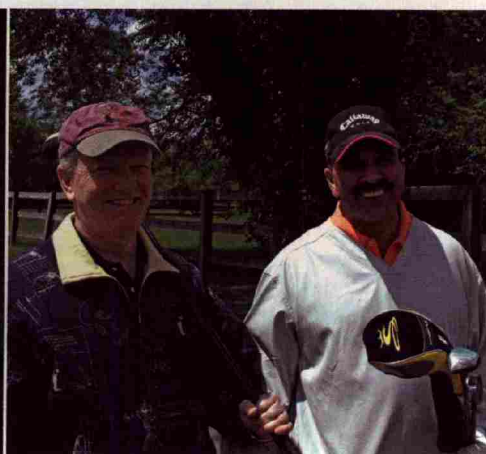
