Newsday Charities, a fund of the McCormick Foundation, provides grant funding to help children and families at risk on Long Island. It raises money through two public campaigns that run in Newsday and on newsday.com. Long Islanders contribute to these campaigns because they want to make a difference and they know a smart way to give when they see it. Every dollar donated received a 50-cent match from the McCormick Foundation and because Newsday and the Foundation cover all administrative costs, 100% of the donations and the match are distributed to local human service agencies caring for people in need.
