

Bank of America Opens New Location in Syosset

Bank Presents \$5,000 Grant to MercyFirst at Ribbon-Cutting Ceremony

Syosset residents, visitors and the men and women doing business now have a new and improved option when it comes to their banking needs. On Jan. 14, a ribbon-cutting ceremony marked the official opening of a new Bank of America banking center at 378 Jericho Turnpike. The location, which replaced the former site at 18 Jackson Avenue, has been serving customers since late November 2010.

“Our new Syosset location features the same level of exceptional service that customers have grown accustomed to, with a number of improvements,” said Jeff Barker, Metro New York region executive, Consumer and Small Business Banking, Bank of America. “Easier access, ample parking and a larger staff are just a few of the ways we have enhanced the overall customer experience.”

At the ceremony, Bank of America officials presented a \$5,000 grant to MercyFirst, a Syosset-based nonprofit. The organization provides an integrated continuum of care for over 4,000 traumatized and neglected children, teenagers and their families at nearly 20 sites throughout Brooklyn, Queens, Nassau and Suffolk counties. The grant builds on a history of local support, including partnerships with Erase Racism, the Long Island Community Foundation, and Variety Child Learning Center.

The full-service banking center features six teller stations in addition to a drive-thru teller for customers on the go. There are two 24-hour ATMs inside the building, and a 24-hour drive-thru ATM for added convenience.

Lobby hours are Monday through Thursday, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Friday 9 a.m. to 6 p.m., and Saturday 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. The drive-thru teller closes one hour earlier on Friday. Customers are also able to access their accounts online, by phone, or through a network of approximately 18,000 ATMs across the country.
